The Parent Support Group (PSG) is a parent liaison group between the school and the BC Community Gaming Grants Branch. Establishing this group allows our school to remain eligible for annual gaming grant funding.

(Note: In public school systems, this group is commonly referred to as the PAC.)

These funds provide valuable extracurricular opportunities for our students — enriching their learning experience beyond the classroom. In recent years, PSG funding has supported:

- Subsidizing school field trip transportation
- Extracurricular activities that make learning more engaging and accessible

The PSG plays an important role by:

- Overseeing the use of grant funds responsibly and transparently
- Supporting ongoing extracurricular opportunities for students
- Acting as a liaison between parents, the school, and the community

This is a meaningful opportunity to get involved and make a direct impact on our school community.
