

QAS Updates – September 3, 2026

Dear QAS Families,

It's hard to believe that September is upon us. We do look forward to welcoming students back to school on Tuesday, September 8th

Students in Grades 1 to 7 will begin class at 8:40 a.m. and be dismissed at 12:00 p.m. All students should be dressed in their full QAS uniform and should bring along a snack and water bottle. Kindergarten students attend class according to the schedule that was sent home separately.

All students should head directly to their Grade's entrance door:

- K- south door on the east side of the building
- Grade 1 – classroom door on the north side of the building
- Grade 2 – classroom door on the east side of the building
- Grade 3 – door on the south side of the building
- Grade 4 – door on the north side of the building, near Gr. 1
- Grade 5 – door on the east side of the building
- Grade 6 – door on the south side of the building
- Grade 7 – hallway door on the north side of the building

Wednesday, September 9th will be a full day for students in Grades 1 to 7. Classes will be in session from 8:40 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. Students should be dressed in full uniform and bring along a snack and lunch. There will be no PE classes on this day. Once again, Kindergarten students are to follow their schedule.

Parking Lot

With the start of school, students are excited and may forget the parking lot routines. Drivers are reminded to park their vehicles and safely ensure that their child exits the vehicle. Please look both ways before crossing into traffic areas. Please keep speed to a minimum. The only drop off and pick up zone is on Fairfax Street.

If a student is riding a bike to school, he or she must walk the bike while on school property. *E-bikes, e-scooters and the like are not permitted on school property, as one must be 16 to operate these modes of transportation.*
